Melissa began planting seeds on a Saturday afternoon. She finished up on Sunday and we placed the trays of seeds in my office beside the pellet stove. Our basil broke ground on Tuesday afternoon with thyme following on Wednesday morning.

Garden Tips

- April in the garden. We just love saying those four little words. April is the best month for planting (or transplanting) ornamental grasses and ground covers. It's also the best time to plant shrubbery and trees. Choose early for the best selection. Several local nurseries such as Eastern Shore Nurseries.
- Harrington's and Garden Treasures allow you to select your plant material and will store it for us to pick up later. If you've chosen stock that's too large to handle, let the nursery care for your plants until you're ready. We can deliver large orders and assist you with

- · Summer blooming bulbs such as dahlias or gladiolas can be planted this month. The soil is now warm enough for bulbs.
- It's a bad idea to cut back the foliage of daffodils and tulips right after they finish blooming. Go ahead and remove the dead flowers and stalks, but leave the leaves until they brown. The plant will store more energy for next year's blooms this way.
