October Garden Tips

* I never get tired of talking about gardens. Here's an unusual one, even for us. This is a "rain garden." It's a shallow depression where a landscape bed has been created. Rainwater from our client's downspouts flow into this bed and not into the Chesapeake Bay. Deeply rooted, mostly indigenous plants help create good drainage.



- * Time to plant those spring flowering bulbs. Try a new variety of daffodil or tulip this year. One of our favorite tulip websites is tuliptown.com. Lots of bulb choices and you can take a virtual tour of their tulip gardens.
- * There is still some great plant material in local nurseries. However, you need to make a decision now about getting plants in the ground. Instead of putting those pots away this fall, how about installing a dwarf conifer with a border of colorful pansies at the base?
- * Leaf removal is the one of the most important things you can do for the health of your lawn at this time of year. Clumps of leaves prevent sunlight from reaching the grass. Without sunlight, photosynthesis can't occur to produce food for your lawn.

We just hung our birdfeeders on large black shepherd's crooks in the back yard. Melissa likes to gently fill the feeders so that the birds can perch and eat, keeping an eye out for predators. I prefer to just throw the seed out on the deck so that I can see our dinner guests a little more closely. You'd think we could agree on something!

Actually, we do agree that we both love fall weather. There's something that just invigorates you when the temperature drops down from the 90+ degree mark of this past summer.

Organic Deer Repellent Program

Tools of the Trade

One of the benefits of having a landscaping business is the opportunity to buy new toys. My latest one is a doozy! I recently purchased a new Ryan Slicer Seeder for my lawn care program.

We use a tractor attachment to aerate and overseed many lawns. However, when a tractor is too large, we'll drop back to a slicer seeder. A slicer seeder still drops grass seed below the surface, depositing it there to germinate.

Sub surface grass seed has a much higher germination rate. Wind won't blow the seed away and birds can't eat it. My old machine gave up the ghost late last year. I got such good results that I just purchased a new and improved model.


